**SCHOOL GATE TIMES : PICK UP AND DROP OFF****Morning Drop-off**

- **Primary drop-off point is at the school main foyer.** Parents must use the one-way system around the school compound, passing by the MPH, to reach the school foyer.
- **Secondary drop-off point is at the school bus waiting area.** The gate here will be closed at 8:00 AM. Any secondary latecomers arriving after 8:00 AM must be dropped off at the Foyer and sign in at the school admin office.
- Please monitor your child's temperature before you set off on your journey to school. Any child displaying a temperature of 37.5, or flu-like symptoms must remain at home.
- Upon arrival at school, duty staff will take the temperatures of all the students before they get out of their vehicles. Any student who has a temperature of 37.2 will be monitored by the school nurses. If their temperature reduces, they may return to lessons, otherwise, parents will be required to come and pick up their child.

## **Afternoon Pick-up**

- **Parents are reminded to remain in their vehicles when collecting their children.**
- In order to comply with the SOP and safety measures for social distancing, parents cannot walk in to pick up their child. We will only release students to cars queuing and coming into the school via routes provided by the school.
- Parents are reminded to come at appointed dismissal times. Please follow the dismissal time of the older brothers/sisters if you have more than 1 child in School. Primary brothers/sisters will remain with a duty teacher in classrooms while waiting for the older brothers/sisters.
- Please note that students are **strictly not allowed** to leave the school grounds on their own either **on foot** or by engaging **Grab Car services. Prior notification is required unless accompanied by a parent/guardian or a person nominated by the parent/guardian.**
- Students are allowed to wait **only within the school grounds** to be collected at the end of the school day.

### HIPPO English Olympiad

This year, CHIS students have participated in the HIPPO English Olympiad for the first time. This is a global competition which assesses students' reading comprehension, creative writing and listening skills. It also allows them to compete against children of their own age from around the globe.



112 CHIS students participated in the Preliminary round of the competition, which we held in school in February. It was a great experience for all of them, and we saw students from Year 1 up to Year 12 participating.

Following the first round, 16 CHIS students qualified for the Semi-final, which was held online during the MCO period. Well done to you all for adapting to take these tests online – we are sure it was not easy!

We are now delighted to announce that one of our students has been placed within the top 150 candidates in his age group from around the world, and will be progressing on to the Final! Huge congratulations to **Han Cheng You!**



Across all age groups, there were only 24 finalists from Malaysia, so this is a huge achievement.

The Final round, which was scheduled to be held in Italy this year, has unfortunately been moved online due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Nevertheless, this is a very prestigious competition and a real test of English ability, and we wish Han Cheng You the very best of luck for his final competition, which takes place in early September.
