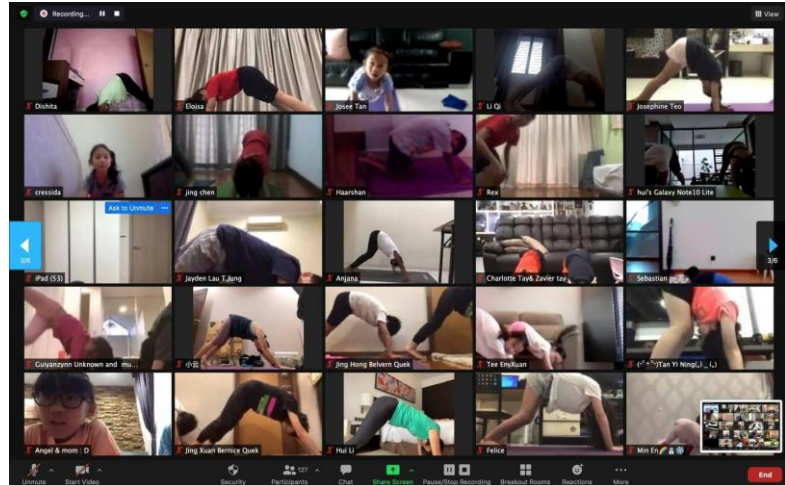


CHIS YOGA FOR WELL-BEING
